Carolina Rodriguez-Figueroa, DDS, MS, is a Clinical Associate Professor of Endodontics at the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry. She completed her DMD/DDS, at Universidad Central de Venezuela, Facultad de Odontologia. She has also completed an international Fellowship / Certificate in Gerodontology at Universidad Complutense de Madrid - Spain and a Fellowship / Certificate in Endodontics at Universidad del Salvador (USAL) & Asociación Odontológica Argentina (AOA) in Buenos Aires - Argentina.
