The first year of dental school does not include a summer semester. Students advance to the next academic year after spring semester. Be aware that financial aid is awarded each summer according to the University's financial aid calendar, meaning that D2 Summer aid will be offered in the same aid year as the D1 Fall & Spring aid, etc.
